This is our Annual Poker Run in Remembrance of Robert Durham. Post Quartermaster Bobby D was riding in a convoy of Vehicles and Motorcycles Back to our Post home after our annual District 5 BBQ at the Jennings War Veterans Home, when a passing truck lost a mattress from it's bed and struck his motorcycle forcing him off the roadway.



Bobby D succumbed to his injuries a week later in the hospital. This event means a great deal to our Post and remembering our Fallen Brother. All Proceeds from the Ride, Raffles and Donations get split between our Riders Group fund and The VFW's Veterans and Military Support Program evenly. Your Donations to The VMS Program help fund three programs initiated by the VFW. They were created to serve our active duty and recently discharged military. Military Assistance Program (MAP) provides financial assistance to Posts, Districts, and Departments that are sponsoring military send offs, homecomings, or other get—together like baby showers for

military wives. It will also assist with postage for Posts and Auxiliaries that are participating in Adopt-a-Unit. Guidelines for applying for these funds can be received from the VFW Veterans and Military Support Office at 816-756-3390.

Unmet Needs provides grants of up to \$1,500 to meet expenses for those actively serving in the military. It was developed to help military families through a financial crisis. Military families could qualify for a grant to help pay for necessities such as rent, car repairs, utilities, and food. To learn more about the program visit wfw.org/assistance/financial-grants.

VFW "Sports Clips Help a Hero Scholarship" awards scholarships of up to \$5,000 to qualifying veterans and service members to help them complete their educational goals without incurring excessive debt.


