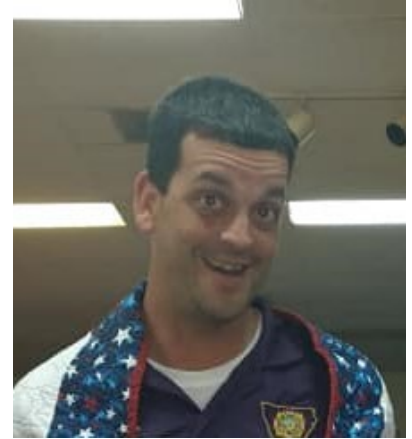

### QM/ADJ Corner

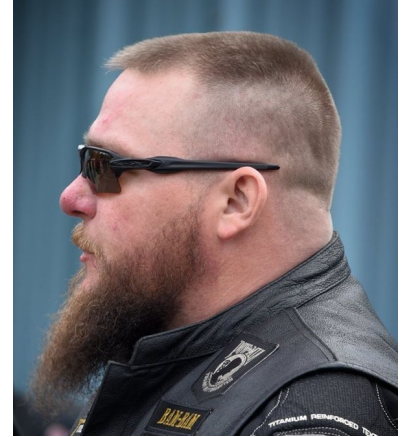
Each year, we talk about helping Veterans, and we talk about serving our community.
