tained major water, wind and structural damage. Yet, its focus was on helping others. For several weeks, members worked to clear power lines and debris to allow access for emergency personnel. But that was only the beginning.

Since the hurricane, the Post has been supporting the community however it can, explained Post Quartermaster Shane Fowler. Members have removed trees and tarped roofs, fixed generators, made fuel runs for those in need, or-ganized and distributed essentials and handed out thousands of pounds of food. The Post fed more than 2,000 people in the first week following the hurricane and collected and distributed more than 200,000 tons of supplies to families in need around the state of Louisiana.

For its truly remarkable efforts, VFW Post 3619 received the 2021 VFW Fred C. Hall Memorial Outstanding Post Special Project Award — an honor well deserved. In addition to its ongoing hurricane-relief efforts, the Post carries on with fun programs and beloved traditions like Blankets for Warm Vets and a Memorial Day Flag Posting. The VFW is proud to recognize the tireless and selfless work of the members of VFW Post 3619 who are #StillServing in so many important ways.

Riders Group Release

Cole-Miers Riders was Proud to hold their 5th Annual Bobby D Memorial Ride to raise money for the VFWs Unmet Needs Program on behalf of the Post.

The Riders also raised money to go to the National Convention in Phoenix next year to ride in the Howard Vander Clute Memorial Ride and help raise even more money for the VMS Program!

Robert "Bobby D" Durham was the Post Quartermaster at the time of his passing and was injured while traveling back from the District 5 BBQ at the Jennings War Veterans Home when a large mattress entered the roadway from a vehicle that was not tied down forcing him from the roadway. Bobby D was instrumental to the Post and Combat Veterans Motorcycle Association and was the driving factor for starting Cole-Miers Riders here at the Post.

On the 5th Annual memorial Ride our Riders lead a group of 50 Bikes over 200 miles safely into Texas and around Toledo Bend and raised close to \$10k. \$3,800 going to the Unmet Needs Program and \$3,800 to send our Riders to Phoenix for the National Convention in 2023. All this could not have been possible without the hard work and dedication of our Ride Chairwomen Gail Combs and the support of the Post and Auxiliary!

The Riders were also a huge part of the nucleus of the Fair booth and it's success this year, with as many as 7 Members volunteering almost every single day.

The Riders we're able to add the remaining to their General fund to continue supporting Veterans and the Community. Like the \$500 Sponsorship the Riders Group donated to CASA Ride for the 387 Legion Riders, and \$150 to 145 Legion Riders Adopt a Senior Ride, and 2x \$250 Gold Sponsors for the Post and Riders through the SWLA War Memorial Fund to help fund the East Beau Veterans Day Celebration.

We are proud to support this Post and Auxiliary and want to remind both Memberships that outside of two Riders Group Members we are also Members and Officers of both Units. Those other 2 Members are Support Members not eligible for VFW or Auxiliary Rolls and huge supporters of almost everything we do here at the Post! Kevin Sharp and Greyson Fowler's Hearts are definitely in the business of taking care of Veterans!
